Endowment Pledge Agreement

The Florida Cattlemen's Foundation, a recognized 501(c)(3) organization, is collecting funds to establish a Beef Cattle Production Professorship at the University of Florida's Department of Animal Sciences. This endowment will support research, teaching, and extension programs that address the research and education priorities of the Florida Beef industry. The goal is to raise \$1 million, with donations accepted immediately or by the summer of 2027, either in lump sums or installments. Contributions can be made in cash, appreciated stock, or real estate and are 100% tax-deductible. If sufficient funds are pledged by the gift agreement signing, the endowment will qualify for an additional \$120,000 from the UF Provost Challenge. The endowment will be collected by the Florida Cattlemen's Foundation, and then transfered to UF to continue in perpetuity. Pledges are due ASAP, with full payment deferred until 2027.
